Camping in God's Great Outdoors

Winter—Fredericksburg RV Park, Fredericksburg February 6-8, Friday-Sunday

Visit an area rich in German (and Lutheran!) heritage in the Texas Hill Country. Enjoy touring restored buildings in the Pioneer Village and navel history in the Admiral Nimitz museum. German foods and shopping galore! Just outside of town is the Wildseed Farms and Biergarten, and Luckenbach, TX—where 'everybody is somebody'!

Spring—Leisure Resort, Fentress May 1-3, Friday-Sunday

Fentress is located just 13 miles from San Marcos (shopping outlets and tourist attractions) on the banks of the San Marcos River. This is an ideal place to vacation with family and friends...you can play and tube in the river, or relax and watch the river flow by.

Fall—Hitchin' Post, Hallsville September 11-13, Friday-Sunday

Enjoy the beauty of the East Texas Piney Woods region at a location near Longview, Marshall, Kilgore, Shreveport, Canton, and Tyler. Fish, canoe and paddle boat on Caddo Lake, or travel just one half hour to Jefferson, a quaint small town featuring museums, antique & gift shops, horse-drawn carriages, and tours by trolley and riverboat.
