What to Bring

Every Day -

- A swimsuit
- Sunscreen and a towel
- Wear sturdy sneakers or tennis shoes
- Old sneakers (you don't mind getting muddy for lake activities)
- A blanket and pillow for rest time
- A Bible (not the family Bible but one that may get 'messed up' a little)

****Valuables, radios, cell phones, iPods, and MP3 players should be left at home****

On the First Day –

- Trading Post money for the week
 - A completed LOMT Health Form
- NO camper will be allowed to stay at camp without a completed and signed health form.**

On special days –

- Occasionally campers may need to bring special items or 'dress up' for special activities. Campers will be told at least one day in advance of the activity and what they might want to bring.

For overnight campouts -

- A sleeping bag and pillow (they do not sleep on cots for the campout)
- Soap, shampoo, etc (campers will be given an opportunity to shower)
- A towel
- Clothes to sleep in
- Clothes for the next day
- A duffel bag or backpack to put their things in
- A flashlight
- Insect Repellent
