## SUMMER DAY CAMP '10

### What A Great Summer Your Child Will Have!

At Day Camp, children ages 5-14 will enjoy playing, running, singing, laughing and learning in the midst of God's creation. You can choose one or up to ten (10) weeks of Day Camp—from June 7 to August 13. Each Monday to Friday Camp Lone Star serves as a world of fun and adventure!

From Check-In at 7:45 a.m. to Check-Out at 5:15 p.m. there is so much to do on the 260 acres of Camp Lone Star. Campers love the pool and lake as well as the ball games, nature study and hiking. Each day the campers will engage in Bible Studies and devotions as well as other activities centered on the 2010 theme of "Mighty To Save" where we share God's awesome plan of salvation.



### Child Supervision

Your child will be cared for in a group of about eight similarly aged campers by a member of Camp Lone Star's summer staff. These college age Christian men and women are carefully selected through a nationwide application and interview process. They complete an intensive (minimum) eight-day on-site training program prior to the beginning of summer camp. The counselors are supervised by Lone Star's fulltime staff.

### What Are Day Camp's Costs?

- 1-2 weeks: \$124 per week  
3 + weeks: \$10 discount allowed per week

- A non-refundable \$40 deposit per camper per week is required with the registration form.
- All remaining balances, fees minus the initial deposit, must be paid by the Wednesday prior to the Monday morning your child begins camp. **Balances paid later than this will incur an additional \$10.00 service charge.**

### What To Bring Each Day?

- a swimsuit (1 piece suit for girls) & towel
- sunscreen & insect repellent
- wear sturdy sneakers or tennis shoes
- old sneakers (for lake activities)
- a blanket and pillow for rest time
- a Bible

Occasionally campers may need to bring clothes for special activities. Campers will be told at least one day in advance of the activity.

### Getting Your Child To Camp

You may drop off and pick up your child from camp at the base camp parking lot each day. (If you find others to carpool with, be sure you supply the driver with the proper paperwork, etc., to be able to check in your child.) The camp is located on Camp Lone Star Road which intersects US Hwy 77 approximately 1,500 feet south of the Colorado River (southern boundary of the city of La Grange). Proceed east on Camp Lone Star Road approximately 2 miles from Hwy 77.

## CAMP LONE STAR

### Thursday Night Campout Option

If your child is between the ages of 8 and 14, he/she has a chance to spend a night at Camp Lone Star camping out under the stars at a campsite. He/she will participate in evening activities with Lone Star's overnight campers, including all-camp games, Round Up and evening devotions.

This option is available to children registered for Weeks #1, 3, 5, 7 & 9. The fee for this option is \$15 per camper per campout, and includes supper and breakfast. A supply list will be included with the confirmation letter of your child's Day Camp Registration.

### Wednesday Picnic

Parents and friends are cordially invited to join the campers for a picnic lunch on Wednesdays served at 12 noon. Please sign up for this in advance so that we have plenty of food for everyone. The cost is \$6.00 per person...which includes seconds!
