LOMT Sunday 2017 Litany — “Love Lives”

Reader 1:

Jacob predicted, “The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler’s staff from between his feet, until tribute comes to him; and to him shall be the obedience of the peoples.” (Gen 49:10)

Congregation: Jesus lives as our victorious King and His reign will endure forever!

Reader 2:

Job foretold, “I know that my Redeemer lives, and at the last he will stand upon the earth. And after my skin has been thus destroyed, yet in my flesh I shall see God, whom I shall see for myself, and my eyes shall behold, and not another.” (Job 19:25-27)

Congregation: Jesus lives as our great Redeemer and we will see Him face-to-face one day!

Reader 1:

Jesus taught, “The Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised.” (Luke 9:22)

Congregation: Jesus lives as our sacrifice that death could not hold!

Reader 2:

The angels at the empty tomb proclaimed, “He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee.” (Luke 24:6)

Congregation: Jesus lives as the Risen Savior!

Reader 1:

Paul writes, “Death is swallowed up in victory! O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?” The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Corinthians 15:55-57)

Congregation: Jesus lives and we do not fear death because Jesus has won!

Reader 2:

Jesus declares, “Fear not, I am the first and the last, and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of Death and Hades.” (Revelation 1:17-18)

Congregation: Jesus lives as the Name Above All Names, and our knees bow down and our tongues confess that He is Lord of All!

Pastor:

“This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters.” (1 John 3:16)

Congregation: Jesus is the Father’s great love for us. He leads us to love the least, the last, the lost, and the lonely. Every time we show love to one another, we live Love.
