## Rev. Ken Hennings to speak at Camp Lone Star's July 29 BBQ & Worship Service

Rev. Ken Hennings, Texas District LCMS President, is the featured speaker at the 11 a.m. outdoor worship service on Sunday, July 29 at Camp Lone Star. **And you are invited!**

In addition to the service, the day includes the traditional barbecue dinner at noon with all the trimmings. (BBQ plates will also be offered via a drive-thru that morning.) Live and silent benefit auctions begin at 1 p.m. indoors in the camp's Koop Center.

Pastor Hennings, elected president of the Texas District in 2006, completes his fourth and final term this summer. He is a 1973 graduate of Concordia Seminary, St. Louis and has served as pastor of Texas congregations in Uvalde, La Pryor and Fort Worth. In 1991, he moved to Austin to serve the Texas District as the Executive Director of the Board of Mission Administration. He also served as Chairman of the Board of Directors of LOMT.

President Hennings and his wife, Val, are members of Redeemer Lutheran Church in Austin. They have four children and seven grandchildren. Upon President Hennings' retirement this summer, he will have served over 45 years in ministry.

Area Lutheran churches provide a delicious BBQ meal served immediately following the service. The BBQ is one of the main events which supports Lutheran Outdoors Ministry of Texas (LOMT) and Camp Lone Star each year. At the 2017 BBQ, more than \$84,000 was raised thanks to dedicated friends. We hope to meet or exceed last year's total in 2018.
