## “Brought Near”

A weekend event for confirmation-age youth!

**Adolescence is a time of changes and transitions:** becoming a teenager, first “jobs”, confirmation, and heading to high school, among others. In the midst of this, Christ speaks words of assurance, “I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” (Mt 28:20) This is one of the truths that will be communicated during Lifequest, a retreat for confirmation-age youth at Camp Lone Star.

**At LIFEQUEST, youth will...**

**Identify transitions taking place and coming up in their lives.**

**Be reminded of God’s constant love and presence throughout these changes.**

**Grow in their understanding of what it means to be a part of Christ’s body.**



**This Friday evening through Sunday late morning weekend at Camp Lone Star will be a “hands-on” experience** for youth and their leaders. Together, youth and adults will spend time in small group Bible studies. Youth will explore topics of support, transition and community while spending time on challenge course activities. Plus, all participants will invest in a project to enhance prayer stations around the Camp Lone Star lake.

**Staff from Camp Lone Star will provide materials and leadership** for Bible studies, devotions, games, activities and challenge course. We hope that adults attending this retreat will spend their time interacting with the youth in their group. Adults are expected to provide supervision for their youth, act as Bible study discussion leaders and care for the medical needs of their group.

**This weekend event costs \$84/youth.** Each group may have one adult attend free. Additional adults are \$25 each. Housing is in climate-controlled cabins, and attendees are expected to bring their own bedding. Up to 11 male youth may attend with each male adult chaperone. Up to 11 female youth may attend with each female adult chaperone. Campers from different youth groups may be housed together.

**Camp Lone Star is located** in La Grange, Texas, about 65 miles east of Austin and 100 miles west of Houston. A letter of confirmation, map to the camp, health form, ‘what to bring’ list, and tentative schedule will be sent to you upon registration.
